



# Parent and Student Signature Page for Participation in the B.Y.O.T. and Google Initiatives

SMSD Elementary Parents;

To permit your child to 1) use personal technology devices when needed, and 2) to obtain a Google applications for educations account, please read, sign, and return this agreement to the school.

1. The student is responsible for keeping his or her own device in their possession or properly securing it, at all times. District personnel are not responsible for the security or condition of student’s personal property.
2. The student is responsible for the proper care of personal technology devices, including all maintenance and repair, replacement or modifications, and software updates necessary to effectively use the device.
3. The District reserves the right to confiscate and/or inspect a personal technology devices if there is reason to believe it was used to violate policies, administrative procedures, school rules, or for general misconduct.
4. Violations of this agreement may result in a temporary or permanent loss of privilege to use personal technology in school, and could also involve disciplinary or legal action.
5. The student must comply with a teachers’ request to a) refrain from using a device, b) verify or display the authentication login screen, or c) to power down (turn off) the device.
6. The student may not use any devices to record, transmit or post photos or video of a person without their knowledge and consent. Images, video, and audio files recorded at school may not be transmitted or posted at any time, without the expressed permission of a district faculty member for instructional purposes.
7. The student should only use personal technology devices with consent and under the direct supervision of a district faculty member and in classroom settings.
8. All faculty, staff, student and guest users are required to access the Internet via the District’s filtered network.
9. Students and staff should use their district Google accounts responsibly for school-related activities.
10. Students and staff are expected to save, access, and share work files using their district Google accounts to increase data availability and network security, and to reduce the use of USB/Flash drives.
